

#### Sutton Coldfield 2 - 2 Ben Rhydding

Ben Rhydding had their first away game of the season against Sutton Coldfield. A game of four-quarters, Ben Rhydding started off strong and in control seeing a few close chances going begging. A well built-up passing sequence lead to a slick goal by Rachel Doherty, lobbing the ball over the diving Sutton Coldfield keeper. Strong defensive corner unit was on show, staving off any Sutton attempts. Half time came around with Rhydding holding onto a narrow 1-0 lead.

The third quarter saw high pressure from Sutton Coldfield and a few Ben Rhydding cards which eventually lead to a goal on the counter attack just before the break. The teams being tied didn't last long and just thirty-seconds after the fourth quarter whistle had blown, Holly Pears turned strong, beating four players on her drive to the top of the circle to calmly put the ball past the Sutton Coldfield goalkeeper with an inch perfect strike.

Unfortunately, Sutton Coldfield responded quickly with an attack against a down-numbered defensive unit. Ben Rhydding threw everything they had to final 10 minutes to try and snatch the win, with Sutton Coldfield also trying to take the points. The game ended up tied at 2-2, both taking a way a point each towards the table.

#### **Men's Team News**

#### **Brooklands 1 - 1 Ben Rhydding**

Ben Rhydding knew there would be up against tougher opposition than the previous week That did not change their confidence going into the game. Ben Pickles was awarded his first cap, well done to a junior member of the squad playing at National League level.

Both teams started with a high pace to the game, Brooklands having the upper half in the first two quarters, pinning Ben Rhydding in their own half for much of the half. Brooklands won several penalty corners (some controversial), but failed to convert. Ross McMillan and Callum Franks were immediately surrounded as soon as they got the ball in midfield, they did well to control the middle as much as they did.

Will Musgrave had an excellent run down the left baseline only find the Brooklands keeper playing rugby against him. Alas, the umpire saw nothing wrong with this even with Musgrave's theatrics in going to ground. Chances were had by both teams, with Ben Rhydding defending well the score was 0-0 at half time.

The second half started with everything to play for. Ben Rhydding knew the opposition were already tiring, and the team had more than enough energy in the legs. A similar story followed, with Brooklands pressing well but the game was more fluid. Brooklands had the best chance of the game so far, breaking from a Ben Rhydding penalty corner. They put the ball wide of an open goal just after keeper Ed Snelling's foot made contact with Matthew Birch's knee. Dave McCollum's professional medical skills had to be brought in, an NHS sponsored magic rub treatment was administered to Birch's knee. Birch was back on his feet in no time.

Just before three-quarter time Brooklands managed to get the ball in the back of the net after a goal line scramble. Not the prettiest of goals to be scored at Brooklands Sports Club, but it put them ahead. Ben Rhydding started to put the pressure on Brooklands in the final quarter. Brooklands found themselves on the wrong side of a few cards while Ben Rhydding kept 11 men on the pitch.

Mark Portnell got a touch on a Charlie Smith strike to send the ball into the roof of the net to bring the scores level. In the next ten minutes Ben Rhydding could have put two or three more goals passed the keeper. However, the Brookland keeper make some excellent saves.

The game ended 1-1. A good performance to stay in the game for the full 70 minutes and get a point from it. Ben Rhydding play Preston at home on Saturday who are yet to get a point in their campaign.

Also last week, **Wakefield** hit three goals as they travelled to **Preston**. Wakefield took the advantage with a Greg Moorhouse double (2,48) and Ethan Stuckley's field goal (8), whilst Josh McGee (55) and Cam Lewis (56) opened their tallies for Preston. Final score **Preston 2 - Wakefield 3**.

Elsewhere in the division, Beeston 2 beat Timperley 3-2and there were 3-3 draws between Didsbury & Hallam and between Leeds and Doncaster.
